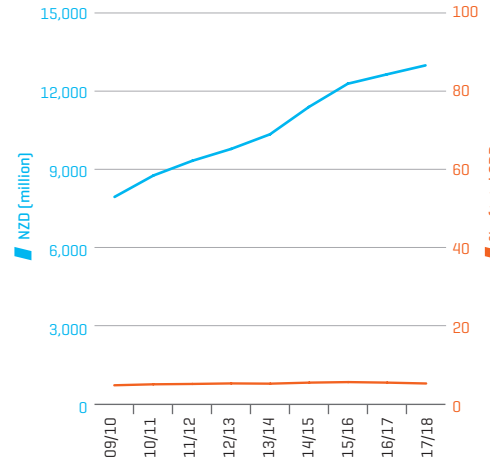




CONTRIBUTION TO THE ECONOMY

CONTRIBUTION OF TRANSPORT & FREIGHT MOVEMENTS TO NZ GDP

In 2017/18, transport and freight movements contributed approximately 13,012 million dollars to GDP (4.9% of total GDP).

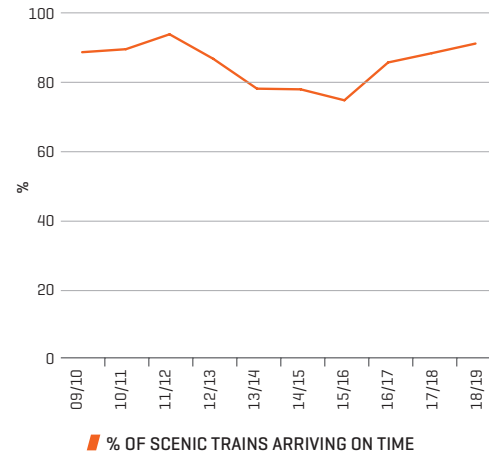

TRAVEL TIME RELIABILITY ON PRIORITY TOURIST ROUTES

In 2018/19, 91% of scenic trains arrived on time (i.e. within 30 minutes of scheduled arrival).

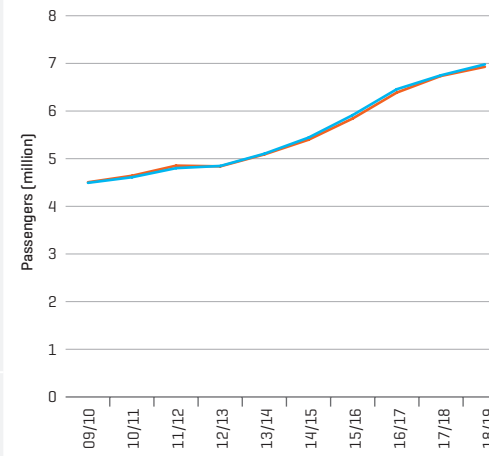

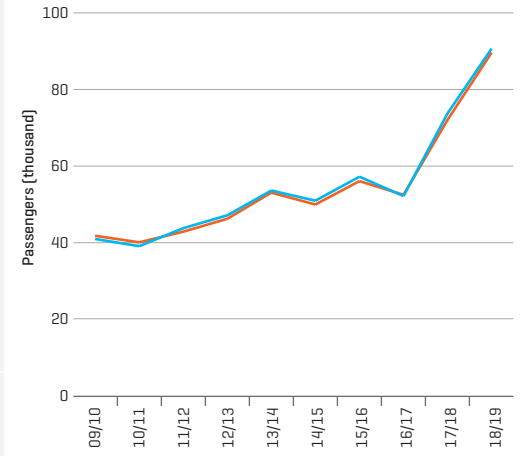
PASSENGERS ARRIVING AND DEPARTING NZ

In 2018/19, the number of passengers arriving and departing by sea were about 90,000 in each direction.

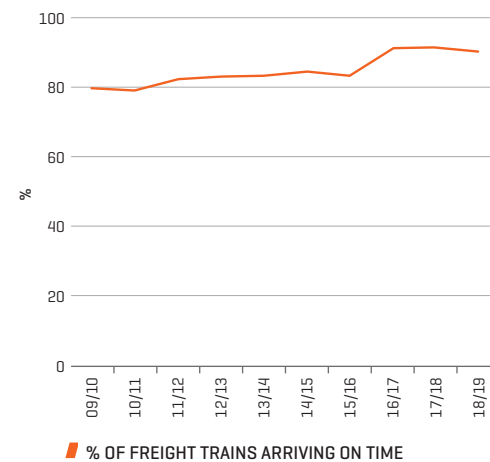

MOVEMENT OF FREIGHT

TRAVEL TIME RELIABILITY FOR FREIGHT TRANSPORTATION

In 2018/19, 90% of freight trains arrived on time (i.e. within 30 minutes of scheduled arrival).

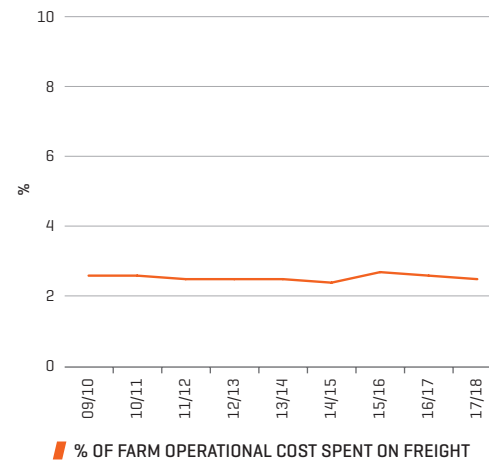

In 2017/18, 2.5% of farm operational costs were spent on freight.

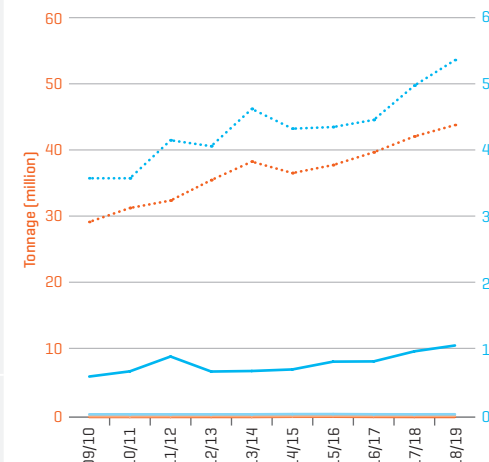

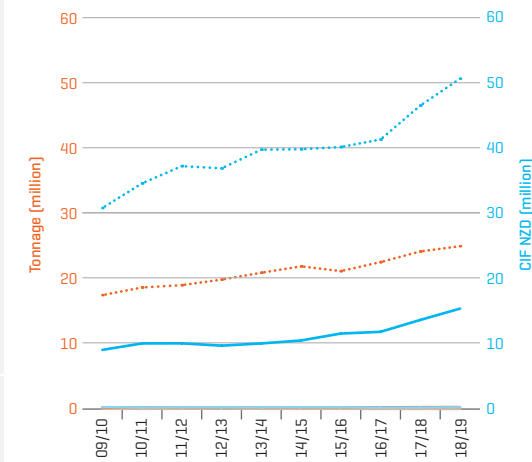
FREIGHT IMPORTS AND EXPORTS

EXPORTS
In 2018/19, total exports were about 44 million tonnes, and valued over 64 billion dollars.

In 2018/19, total imports were about 25 million tonnes, and valued over 65 billion dollars.

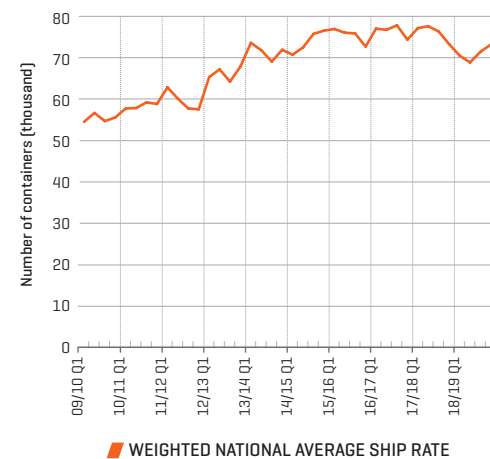

FREIGHT PRODUCTIVITY / UTILISATION

In 2018/19, the averaged number of containers moved on or off ships were between 69,000 and 73,000 per hour.

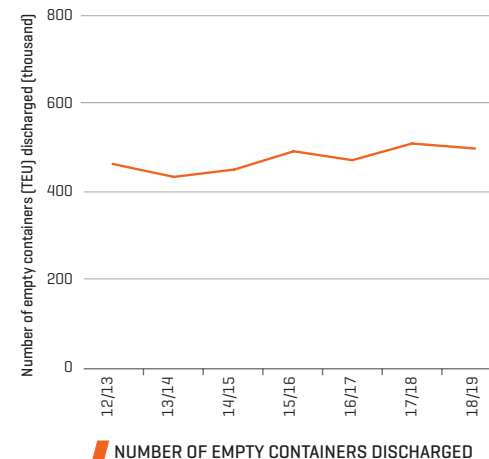

In 2018/19, the number of empty containers discharged at all ports totalled approximately 497,000 TEUs.

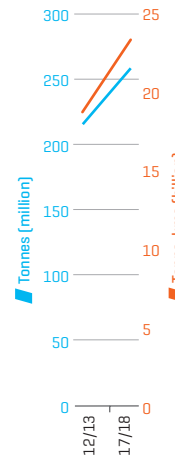

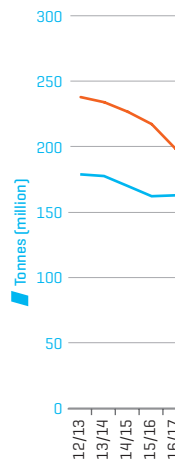
FREIGHT CARRIED DOMESTICALLY (LOCAL AND REGIONAL)

ROAD
In 2017/18, road freight carried domestically totalled 258.5 million tonnes (or 23.1 billion tonne kilometres).



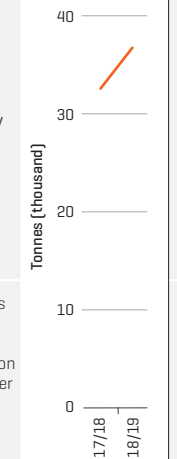

In 2018/19, rail freight carried domestically totalled 171.3 million tonnes (or 38.3 billion tonne kilometres).



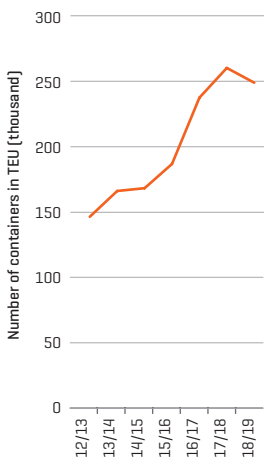
